

For Immediate Release: Concert in support of the Relief Efforts in Nepal

St Georges Anglican Church in Trenton is holding a benefit concert Saturday evening May 2nd at 7pm to raise money to help the people of Nepal effected by the earthquake there. This earthquake has had a huge impact on the people, both in loss of life and destruction of buildings and infrastructure.

The money will go to the Primates World Relief and Development Fund (PWRDF), who have an excellent long term track record at getting donations to the projects and people that donations are targeted for. Any funds given will be matched 1 for 1 by the Canadian Government, so giving in this way is a good way to ensure great bang for your buck.

The Concert will be given by the group "SIDEBAR" from Oakville beginning at 7 pm in the church, on Byron and John St in Trenton. They will perform a variety of music, and feature a band and vocalists who perform tight vocal harmonization of pieces from the 20's to the very recent.

This concert is part of St. Georges 170th anniversary celebrations, and had originally been meant be used by the local church to provide programs such as their very popular Messy church program. Rev Steve Timpson stated that "St Georges is very committed to these programs and will continue to expand them, but the church leadership was so struck by the current intense need in Nepal, that they wanted to do something quickly for the situation."

Donations of any amount will be received at the concert, (an admission fee itself is going to be waved) and gifts of over \$10 will be provided with a tax receipt. Gifts can also be delivered to the church office on John St in Trenton for the next three weeks.
