

A History of Christ Church Glen Miller

The congregation of Christ Church Glen Miller was established in 1843 and an Anglican church was built along the Trent Severn Waterway in the heart of the former Glen Miller Village which is now part of Quinte West. The original church was located in the parking lot just to the north of the present church, but it burned down in 1947. From 1947 to 1950 the congregation met at the paper mill club house for Sunday worship. The church as it is today was bought for \$1.00 and the money was donated back to the church. Some major renovations were done to the original building to make it into a church with beautiful stained glass windows. In 1989 an addition 26 by 40 feet was built onto the old kitchen. In 2002, we outgrew the first addition and a 40 by 40 foot second addition was completed in June 2003. This addition was built by dedicated congregation volunteers and is now home to many community gatherings. In 2007, a new sign was erected to inform people who we were and what we do. In 2009 we were fortunate to have a circular drive and part of our parking lot paved.

There are currently about 50 families in our congregation. We are a committed group who support many worthwhile projects. We sponsor a buffet lunch every month in our church hall and serve approximately 100-115 people. People can come out for a nutritious meal, and also enjoy a social hour visiting friends and neighbours. Once a month we serve a dinner on a Saturday evening which is quite popular.

We also cater to banquets, anniversaries and Christmas parties in our church hall.

Our building is also used by many groups such as the Glen Miller Quilt Club, Youth groups, congregational meetings as well as individual rentals for private functions. Christ Church is the community Church of Glen Miller.



Our church services are at 9:00 am most Sundays with Sunday school at the same time. We have communion at least three times per month. After church we have a social time with refreshments!

In 2007 Christ Church became part of the Anglican Churches of Quinte West **which includes Holy Trinity Frankford and St. George's Trenton.**

Our ministers serve all three communities!

Christ Church Glen Miller has a great deal to offer all ages.

Sunday School: Christ Church offers Sunday School during our 9:00 am service. On communion Sundays, children rejoin their parents in time to receive the sacrament or a blessing. The curriculum used is "The Whole People of God".

Youth: Our congregation is always looking for ways to provide spiritual growth and care for the youth of our Community and Children are always welcome. During the summer we put together a kid's afternoon of fun, games, crafts and food which is enjoyed by the young and young at heart. The church often opens their facilities to youth groups such as Girl Guides at no charge. Every Christmas the Anglican Church Women (ACW) supports the adopt-a-child program.

Adults: You are only a stranger the first day. Our congregation is small and we heartily welcome new individuals or families. There is always coffee after church and often treats.

Our music is usually upbeat and lively with congregation members sometimes dancing or swaying in their seats. If you like to sing there is room for you in the choir. We usually practice after church. Once or twice a year we join other choirs to enhance our singing skills.

The men's club helps out by putting on dinners and lunches once every month. Although it is called the men's club, women are invited to help out also.

The **Anglican Church Women's** group meets as required and usually after church. All women are welcome. They raise money through spring and fall teas which is used to support the church and community outreach.

Worship: Lay people are an important part of our congregation. Their roles vary from Lay Readers, Servers, Altar Guild members and more. We welcome and train volunteers. If the spirit moves you, we can help you find ways to share your gifts. We are open to new and old ideas to worship and are working to know Jesus and the bible better. We are active in bible study, and outdoor and contemporary church services take place from time to time.

Pastoral Care: A team of lay people provide home visits to members who are sick or shut-in.

Christ Church Family: From children to adults to seniors, as one of our warm up songs says, "You are a part of the family!"
