

A History of Holy Trinity Frankford.

Holy Trinity Anglican Church was established and built in the Village of Frankford in 1876. It is written that services were held prior to that date at the Methodist Episcopal Church on the site where the United Church now stands. Canon Bleasdel and Canon Armstrong of St. George's Anglican Church in Trenton were prominent leaders in those days. The Church was built in traditional style and pews replaced chairs in 1902, as well as electricity and a furnace to replace the pot belly stove that sat in the back of the Church. The Church's stained glass windows are prominent and the Good Shepherd window is cherished by the congregation.

A Parish stable built in the early 1900's was replaced first by a hall and in 1988 by the present Trinity Hall. The hall is used for a variety of event held by the Church and the community including fundraising, receptions. Community Groups such as Grieving Families and Health and Wellness Programmes are also held at the hall. Holy Trinity has in the past been an independent Church and has been associated with St. John's in Stirling, Christ Church, Glen Miller and is presently enjoying association with St. George's in Trenton as part of the Anglican Churches of Quinte West. Our Parishioners are both urban/rural families and we would welcome you in joining us.

Service Times

Services are held every Sunday at 10:30 a.m. Our service, shown on the overhead screen follows the Book of Alternative service. When available, Sunday School is held in Trinity Hall during the service and the children join the rest of the congregation part way through the service. Following our service, parishioners meet for refreshments and fellowship at the back of the church, or in the Hall if Vestry Council is meeting.

In 2007 Holy Trinity, Frankford became part of the Anglican Churches of Quinte West **which includes Christ Church Glen Miller and St. George's Trenton.**

Sunday School: At the present time, Sunday School is available on request.

Pastoral Care: Our Lay Readers and a team of lay people provide visits and calls to members who are ill, shut in or bereaved. They may bring Communion if requested. Seniors are invited twice a year to join with others at St. George's, one of our sister Churches to worship together and enjoy each others company over some light refreshments.

Circle of Christian Women: Once a Month, ACQW hosts an evening St. George's Parish Hall for fellowship, mutual support and fun. Guest presenters speak on a variety of topics from mission and outreach, to maintaining mental health, to creating Christmas centre pieces. Members of Holy Trinity are invited to participate.

Music Programme: Our music is led by Maggie and Peter George and Pat Gadsby. Hymns are chosen to reflect the seasons and the lessons of the day, with participation of members of the congregation.

Anglican Church Women: We meet monthly or as needed to plan and prepare for luncheons, receptions and other events held for the congregation and our wider community. We are fortunate to have men in the congregation to assist us as needed!

Worship: Members of the Congregation are active in the worship services as Readers, Lectors, Greeters, Intercessors and Altar Guild and in technical support. All are welcome to participate and training is provided as needed.

Social: During the year we prepare and serve six soup and Sandwich Luncheons, as well as our Annual Bazaar in October. We also prepare luncheons and receptions for special occasions and events in the lives of our parishioners. All members are welcome to participate in whatever capacity they wish.

Holy Trinity Cemetery: Located on the Frankford/Walbridge Road, just east of the village, this lovely spot has served our community for years as a place of rest for all who prefer a Christian burial or interment of ashes. Volunteers to serve on the Cemetery Board to continue the care of this sacred place are welcomed.
